

OTHER LEARNING EXPENSE SUBSIDIES

American Sign Language (ASL) interpretation is an allowable expense for assessment. Assistive learning devices will also be considered for reimbursement. These expenses and other expenses that are barriers to learning for LBS learners (including, but not limited to: internet, tablets, computers, laptops, cell phones) are under the discretion of the individual literacy & basic skills agency or program.

The Wellington County Learning Centre reserves the right to limit or stop any Learner's subsidy when funds are limited or run out.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to be eligible to receive Training Support, claimants must:

- **be eligible for and enrolled in the LBS Programs**
- **under their current situation, learners are finding they have to make difficult decisions between learning and basic needs**
- **the Market Basket Measure can also be used to determine eligibility**

Learners are not eligible to receive money to pay for childcare or transportation from more than one government source during their participation in the LBS Program.
